

# ALEXANDER RUTHERFORD SCHOLARSHIPS FOR HIGH SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT

## ELIGIBLE COURSES

### GRADE 10

Average of 80.0% or higher in 5 subjects:

- One of:  
**English 10-1, 10-2**, or Français 10, 13
- Two of the following:
  - Pure Mathematics 10, or Applied Mathematics 10
  - Science 10
  - Social Studies 10
  - A language other than the one used above at the grade 10 level
- Any two other courses at the Grade 10 level including those listed above and Introductory C.T.S. courses. See exceptions below.

### GRADE 11

Average of 80.0% or higher in 5 subjects:

- One of:  
**English 20-1, 20-2**, or Français 20, 23
- Two of the following:
  - Pure Mathematics 20, or Applied Mathematics 20
  - Science 20
  - Biology 20
  - Chemistry 20
  - Physics 20
  - Social Studies 20
  - A language other than the one used above at the Grade 11 level
- Any two other courses at the Grade 11 level including those listed above and Intermediate C.T.S. courses. See exceptions below.

**C.T.S. Courses:** Three one credit courses can be combined and used as one of the other courses at the Grade 10 and or Grade 11 level.

- to be combined, all courses must be from the same level (Introductory or Intermediate)
- the average mark of the three courses may be used as one of the other subjects at the appropriate level.

### GRADE 12

Average of 80.0% or higher in 5 subjects:

- One of:  
English 30, **English 30-1**,  
**English 30-2**, or Français 30
- Four of the following:
  - Pure Mathematics 30
  - Applied Mathematics 30
  - Mathematics 31
  - Science 30
  - Biology 30
  - Chemistry 30
  - Physics 30
  - Social Studies 30
  - Any **one** language other than the one used above at the Grade 12 level.

### NOTE:

- French and Français are not the same course, and are not interchangeable.
- All courses used for scholarship purposes must have a **minimum three credit value**.
- Only marks obtained prior to post-secondary study can be used.
- A course cannot be repeated after a higher level course has been taken in the same series.
- Eligibility is restricted to grades obtained while a resident of Alberta.
- Driver Education, Work Experience and Special Projects will not be used when calculating a student's average.
